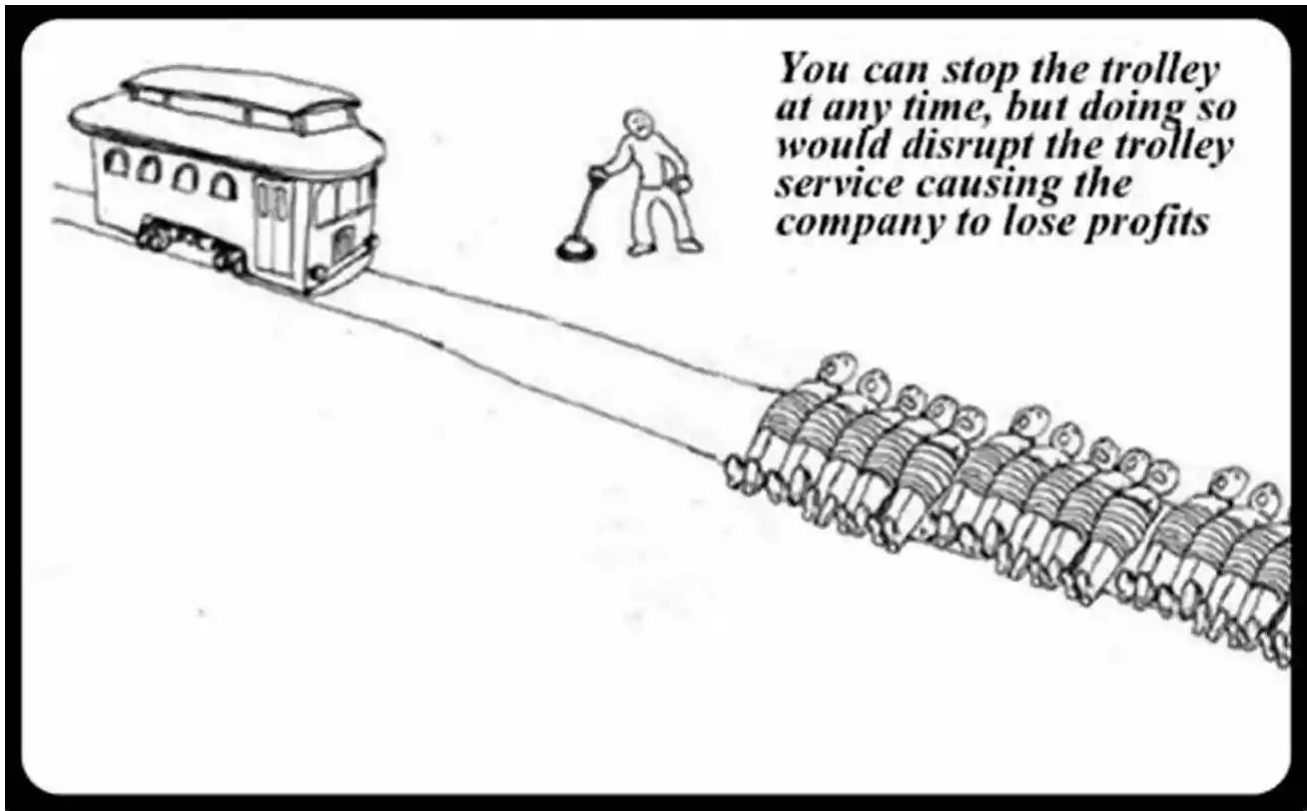
- Dostoevsky: God and evil are not reconcilable: evil is real, so is God, and that situation is senseless
