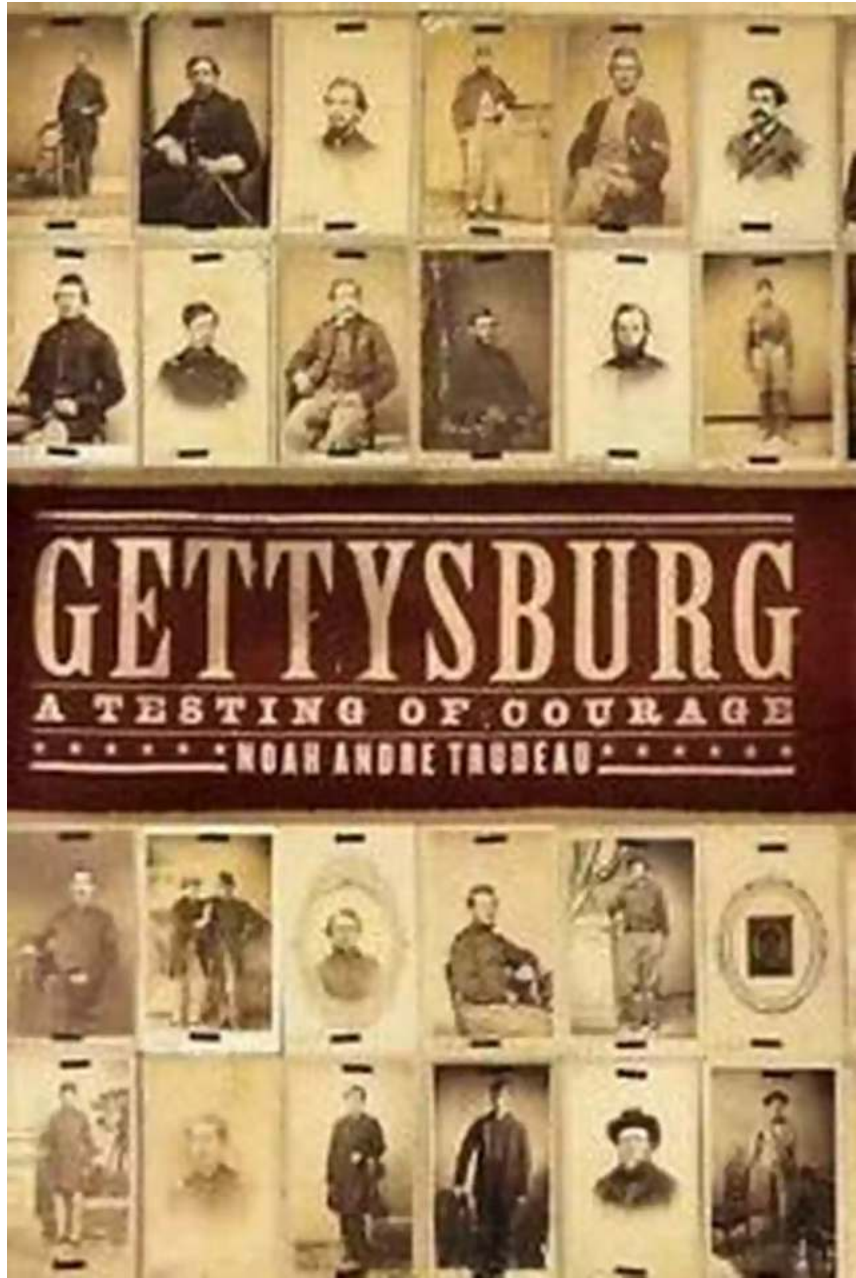


Gettysburg Testing Of Courage - The Epic Battle That Shaped a Nation

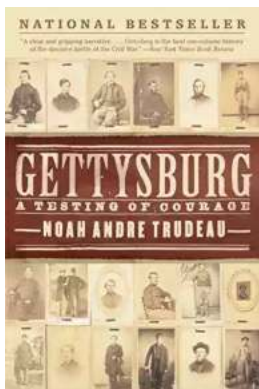
