






A devastating ambush in Iraq, kidnapped soldiers, and the men who wouldn't leave their comrades behind

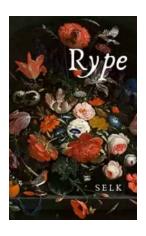
