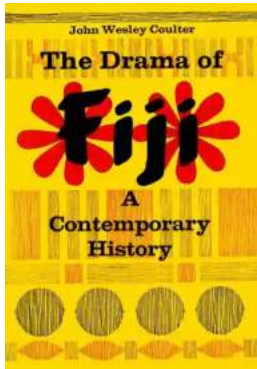

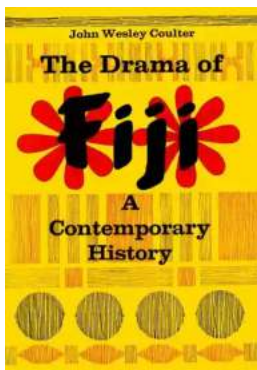

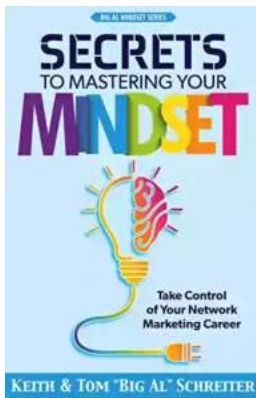


This history of Fiji focuses on the period of Imperial British control and offers a fascinating glimpse at a unique and volatile situation.

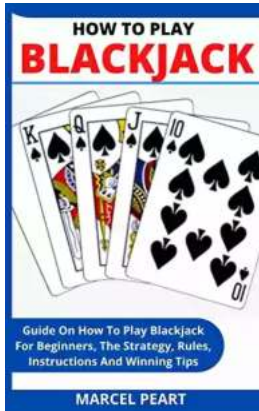

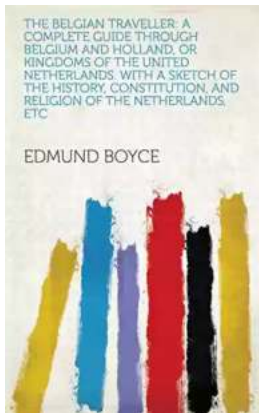
