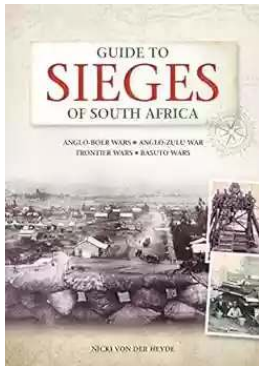

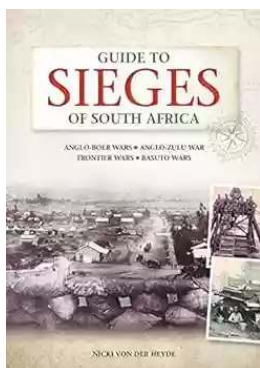
The Basuto Wars
