

Despite the fact that there are 12 identified species of Tiliqua, only five of them are routinely maintained in the United States due to tight export prohibitions on



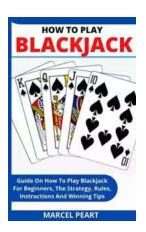
