

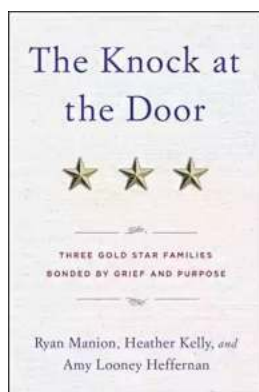
Three Gold Star Families Bonded By Grief And Purpose

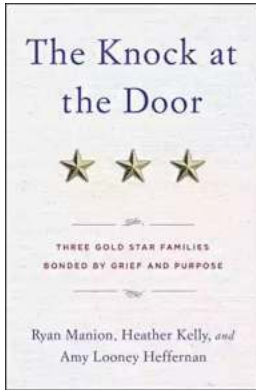
